Implementation

UX Psychology

Principle: First impressions count

Application: Use the homepage to build trust quickly by showing what you offer and who you serve.

Implementation: Place a short summary and friendly product images at the top of the main page.

Principle: Ease of use keeps people engaged

Application: Visitors should never struggle to find products or how to contact you.

Implementation: Keep menus simple, show 'Contact' and 'Shop Now' buttons clearly, and avoid complicated layouts.

Content Strategy

Area: Product Pages

Recommendation: Each main area (cosmetics, hair, skin, wellness) should have its own page with easy-to-read descriptions and actual product images.

Implementation: Summarize the benefit of each category simply and add real photos from your uploads. Use your referral link for 'Shop now'.

Area: Brand Message

Recommendation: Use the slogan 'Be your magnificent self' in key places to help visitors remember your brand.

Implementation: Place the slogan under your logo and once in your About area.

Conversion Optimization

Implementation: Add a straightforward contact form on its own page and mention what response time customers can expect.

Priority Focus

Category: Product visibility and clarity

Description: Make your main products and shop link stand out.

Reason: This is not a store itself, so visitors need clear direction to buy from the referral link.

Category: Contact form

Description: Make the contact form easy to find even before contact details (phone/email) are finalized.

Reason: Customers may want to get in touch right away with questions.

Implementation Order

1. Homepage summary and clear value statement
2. Product category pages with real images and 'Shop now' buttons
3. Simple navigation and main menu setup
4. Contact form page setup
5. Add placeholder text logo and color scheme
6. Double-check for easy mobile use and loading speed

Risk Mitigation

No direct shopping or eCommerce

Category: Customer confusion

Suggested Action: Clearly explain that purchases are made through the linked referral shop, not directly on this website.

Missing phone/email at launch

Category: Customer frustration

Suggested Action: State that additional contact options (like email) are coming soon, and focus on the contact form until set up.
