- Professional photo of owner or team

Strategy: Build trust and credibility by showing the people behind the company.

Psychology: Visitors are more likely to do business with someone they feel they know and trust.

Tone: Be genuine, approachable, and trustworthy. Use simple, real-life stories.

Civil Engineering Services (Service)

Purpose: Explain the range of civil engineering solutions offered, so potential clients quickly see how you can help their specific projects.

Sections

Service Details

Purpose: List your civil engineering services and show what makes your approach stand out.

Key Elements:

Implementation

UX Psychology

Principle: Clarity and Trust

Application: Show business experience and regional expertise right away on the homepage and service pages.

Implementation: Add a short summary on the homepage highlighting over 35 years' experience and a local focus, supported by a real logo and genuine project images.

Principle: Ease of Use

Application: Make sure anyone can find contact info, services, and how to start a project without feeling lost.

Implementation: Use a clear menu at the top of each page and a simple call-to-action, like 'Get in Touch' or 'Request a Quote', placed in obvious places.

Principle: Social Proof

Application: Show examples of past work to build trust.

Implementation: Add project images or a short list of completed project types on service pages.

Content Strategy

Area: Home Page

Recommendation: Write a clear and friendly welcome message that explains what you do and who you serve.

Implementation: Use the business overview to write a paragraph at the top of the homepage. Mention experience, commitment to quality, and local ties.

Area: Service Pages

Recommendation: Break down each main service (Civil Engineering, Land Surveying, Construction Staking) into easy-to-read sections.

Implementation: Use bullet points for each type of work and add a short sentence describing each service, focusing on real-life benefits for local customers.

Technique: Short and Simple Contact Form

Rationale: Shorter forms get more responses and reduce the chances of people leaving.

Implementation: Ask only for key details like name, phone, email, and a short message on the contact page.

Technique: Show Service Areas Clearly

Rationale: When customers see their county or region listed, they know you serve them, increasing the chance they'll reach out.

Implementation: Include a section or map showing all the counties and cities served in Northeast Michigan.

Priority Focus

Category: Contact and Service Access

Description: Make it easy for visitors to contact the business and find out what services are offered.

Reason: Visitors who cannot easily find how to start a project or get more information are unlikely to become clients.

Category: Local SEO and Directory Listings

Description: Ensure listings and targeted keywords focus on Northeast Michigan counties.

Reason: Most clients will search for engineering and surveying services with location-specific terms. Accurate directory listings boost local credibility and search visibility.

Implementation Order

1. Set up basic website structure and menu
2. Add accurate business details to header, footer, and contact page
3. Create service pages with clear descriptions and contact options
4. Upload logo and project images, add professional photos where needed
5. Add strong calls-to-action throughout the site
6. Activate business directory and ensure accuracy
7. Apply keywords and regional SEO content
8. Test for mobile use and speed
9. Final review for simplicity and consistency

Risk Mitigation

Missing or Inconsistent Contact Information

Category: Trust

Suggested Action: Double-check that phone, email, and address are the same everywhere on the site and on directory listings.

Slow Loading Images

Category: Loading Speed

Suggested Action: Make sure all uploaded and stock images are compressed and resized to avoid slow page loads.

Unclear Services for Non-Experts

Category: Clarity

Suggested Action: Make service descriptions simple and clear, with extra explanation where technical terms are needed.
