Imagery Style

- Do not use overly bright or playful colors—this could seem unprofessional for technical global customers.
- Skip stock photos with people using personal protective equipment unless they are real images from the business.

Requirements & Features

Homepage Presentation

Description: Make sure visitors easily see what types of high-temperature ceramic materials you offer right from the homepage. Point out the unique strengths, years of experience, and certifications.

Validation: Visitors immediately understand what the business offers and its certifications from the homepage.

Rotating Banner

Description: Use a rotating banner on the homepage to showcase top products and highlight real applications. Use clear, sharp images the customer provided.

Validation: Rotating banner cycles through top product images with captions.

Product Gallery

Description: Present sample images of different ceramics and applications in a well-organized gallery, so buyers can see your product range at a glance.

Validation: Gallery shows multiple images, separated by product type.

Custom Contact Form

Description: Provide a simple, professional contact form that captures the key information buyers need to share. Include file upload for drawings or specs.

Validation: Form fields include contact details, product needs, application, timeframe, and file upload. Submissions route to sales@zircarzirconia.com.

Ecommerce Store with Member Login

Description: Set up an online store with pricing, product details, and ordering. The store is only viewable after customers login so only approved buyers can view and purchase products.

Implementation

UX Psychology

Principle: Clarity and Trust

Application: Buyers decide quickly if your business is credible. Highlight certifications, experience, and safety up front.

Implementation: Place ISO certification badges and quality policy at the top of key pages, and mention years of experience near the first paragraph.

Principle: Easy Navigation

Application: Procurement managers and technical staff want to find products and data sheets quickly.

Implementation: Use simple menu names like 'Products', 'Industries', 'Technical Data', and keep navigation links visible at all times.

Principle: Visual Proof and Social Validation

Application: Seeing real product images, industry examples, and certificates builds confidence.

Implementation: Fill banners and galleries with real photos and use labels. Where possible, add customer logos or testimonials from labs or universities.

Content Strategy

Area: Product Pages

Recommendation: Make each product easy to review – use short, clear descriptions, practical applications, supported by sharp images and direct links to data sheets.

Implementation: Add 1-2 sentences summarizing each product's key benefits. Place a 'Download PDF' button and use the real specs and safety sheets provided.

Area: Industry Solution Pages

Recommendation: Show clear examples for different industries (aerospace, nuclear, etc.) and describe how your ceramics solve real problems.

Implementation: For each industry page, list key uses and include case studies or success stories if available.

Area: Quality and Accreditation

Recommendation: Present certifications, safety policies, and quality commitments where buyers look first.

Implementation: Add a dedicated 'Quality' page and call out ISO certification in site footer and product pages.

Conversion Optimization

Technique: Strong Calls-to-Action

Rationale: Buyers and researchers are often ready to request more info or start a quote. Direct, visible buttons reduce hesitation.

Implementation: On each page, add a clear button to 'Contact Us', 'Request a Quote', or 'Download Data Sheet'. Make sure these link to the contact form or download.

Technique: Contact Form Simplicity

Rationale: Reducing the number of steps and making forms easy lowers drop-off.

Implementation: Keep only necessary form fields and highlight file upload for drawings/specs. Clearly state response time frames.

Technique: Members-Only Store

Rationale: Restricting access to the store creates a sense of exclusivity and helps ensure buyers register and reach out.

Implementation: Show a simple login/register message on the store page if not logged in. Approve new users quickly.

Priority Focus

Category: Homepage Clarity and Navigation

Description: Buyers need to instantly understand what you offer and quickly reach the info, products, or contact form they're after.

Reason: Lost or confused visitors are less likely to contact you or start an order. A clear homepage and navigation keep them engaged.

Category: Store Security and User Access

Description: Only show pricing and product details to logged-in, approved users.

Reason: B2B buyers expect security and privacy especially for special pricing or technical materials. This protects your business too.

Category: Accreditation and Safety Transparency

Description: Display ISO certification, quality policy, and data sheets without barriers.

Reason: This audience values verified quality and safety above all else. Make it easy for them to find and download needed files.

Implementation Order

1. Set homepage with rotating banner, business details, and certifications
2. Add all product and industry solution pages with galleries, sharp images, and clear descriptions
3. Set up and test the web store with member login required
4. Add the custom contact form and test submission and file uploads
5. Review all images and PDFs for clarity and update any unclear files
6. Perform store and form security testing before going live
7. Final check of navigation links and make sure all pages are reachable from main menu

Risk Mitigation

Unauthorized store access

Category: Security

Suggested Action: Test the login and membership process before launch. Set up an approval workflow for new buyers.

Form spam and junk submissions

Category: Operations

Suggested Action: Add a simple check or CAPTCHA to the contact form to block bots and spam.

Slow page speed with many images

Category: Performance

Suggested Action: Review and resize all images before uploading; use only sharp, web-ready files to ensure fast loading.

Outdated or missing product data

Category: Content Management

Suggested Action: Assign a team member to review product pages monthly and update descriptions and data sheets as needed.
