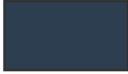

Requirements & Features

Contact Information

Strategy: Reduce steps—keep it short and remove friction.

Psychology: People get nervous about long forms. Short and simple gets more replies.

Tone: Friendly and approachable.

Contact Info

Purpose: Show all the ways people can connect with you.

Key Elements:

- Business email
- Phone number
- Link to Facebook page

Strategy: Give clear options so each visitor can choose what's easiest for them.

Psychology: Trust increases when real contact info is shown.

Tone: Direct and open.

Hours Location

Purpose: Let visitors know when they can expect a response and where you are based.

Key Elements:

- Hours of operation (Monday-Sunday: 9:00 AM–5:00 PM)
- Service area (Barbour County, AL, and surrounding areas)
- Note: physical address not displayed publicly, as preferred

Strategy: Set clear expectations for replies; build trust through transparency.

Psychology: Honesty about availability avoids frustration and confusion.

Tone: Plain language, reassuring.

UX Psychology

Principle: Clarity and Trust

Application: Make all essential information about your programs, location, and contact options easy to find. Use professional photos and a clean design to create a sense of trust.

Implementation: Highlight your main services and contact details at the top of each page. Use photos of students and medical equipment that reflect your training environment.

Principle: Ease of Navigation

Application: Help visitors find what they need quickly, especially on mobile phones.

Implementation: Use a simple menu with clear labels for programs, enrollment, and contact. Make sure visitors can sign up for classes or ask questions with just a couple of clicks.

Content Strategy

Area: Program Descriptions

Recommendation: Use plain language to describe programs, who they are for, what students will learn, and how to enroll.

Implementation: Each program page should have short paragraphs, bullet points, and a clear contact or sign-up button.

Area: Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Recommendation: Anticipate common questions and provide answers in a FAQs section.

Implementation: Add an FAQ section covering enrollment, schedules, payment, and certification steps.

Recommendation: Mention your Barbour County and Alabama focus to connect with local students.

Conversion Optimization

Description: Making the website easy to use on smartphones.

Reason: Most people will use their phones to find you and sign up for programs.

Category: Program Information

Description: Clear information on each program and how to enroll.

Reason: So visitors understand what you offer and how to take the next step.

Category: Trust and Professional Image

Description: Use of branding, professional images, and a clean layout.

Reason: Builds trust and shows your school is credible and reliable.

Implementation Order

1. Set up contact details and business directory listings
2. Design for mobile and add branding colors, logo, and healthcare images
3. Write and add clear program descriptions and FAQ section
4. Add and test contact form
5. Prepare for payment feature by planning spot for payment link and confirmation steps
6. Link to Facebook and promote updates

Risk Mitigation

Confusing Payment Options

Category: Enrollment

Suggested Action: Add clear wording that payment features will be available soon and provide other ways to get information if needed.

Outdated or Inconsistent Information

Category: Directory Listings

Suggested Action: Regularly check all listings and make sure your business name, phone, and email match your website.

Broken Forms or Links

Category: User Experience

Suggested Action: Test all forms and links on the website and correct any broken ones before launching the site.
