Validation: Form is easy to find and fill out. Works on computers and phones. Confirmation message is shown after submitting.

Home Page Content

Risk Mitigation

Too many large images may slow down the website

Category: Performance

Suggested Action: Shrink image sizes before uploading and use an image optimizer tool.

Banners or galleries not working on phones

Category: Accessibility

Suggested Action: Test all banners and galleries on different devices to make sure everything displays and works correctly.

Potential confusion over included services or hours

Category: Content Clarity

Suggested Action: Clearly state what is and isn't included for each tour and provide the specific operating hours where users expect to find them.
