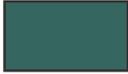

Imagery Style

Sections

Hero

Implementation

UX Psychology

Principle: First impressions matter

Application: Use calm colors and professional images up front to help visitors feel welcome and safe.

Implementation: Make sure the homepage banner includes soothing visuals and easy-to-read text that shows what services are offered.

Principle: Reduce anxiety and confusion

Application: Clearly explain how to contact and book services so visitors don't feel lost.

Implementation: Add step-by-step instructions or short explanations on booking forms and contact page.

Principle: Build trust quickly

Application: Show certifications and emergency resources where visitors see them first.

Implementation: Place badges and the emergency number in a spot that's obvious, like at the top of a sidebar or right on the homepage.

Content Strategy

Area: Service Descriptions

Recommendation: Use short descriptions that get to the point for each service offered.

Implementation: Write a brief summary for each service and avoid complex language so all visitors can understand easily.

Area: Visual Branding

Recommendation: Use strong brand visuals that reflect the business's values and requested color themes.

Implementation: Apply the Gustav Klimt-inspired colors and shapes throughout the site, especially in banners and backgrounds.

Area: Offers and Pricing Info

Recommendation: Highlight special offers like free consultation and sliding scale pricing; keep other fee details off the website per instructions.

Implementation: Show offers as a callout or section on the homepage and leave out hourly rate and retainer models.

Conversion Optimization

Technique: Make appointment request simple

Rationale: Easy booking increases conversion by letting visitors take action right away.

Implementation: Place the appointment request form on the contact page, labeled clearly, with a few fields to fill out.

Technique: Clear calls to action

Rationale: Direct language helps visitors know what steps to take next.

Implementation: Use buttons like 'Book Now', 'Contact Us', and 'Free Consultation' all over the site.

Technique: Show proof of expertise

Rationale: Credentials and badges reassure visitors and help them choose your business.

Implementation: Add certification images, badges, and links to social profiles in a sidebar or footer.

Priority Focus

Category: Easy Appointment Booking

Description: Let visitors book appointments quickly and see service hours clearly.

Reason: This is key for getting new visitors to become clients and reduces drop-off.

Category: Homepage Visuals

Description: Strong, calming banner images and color themes to start the visitor journey.

Reason: Sets the right tone and helps visitors feel safe, welcome, and confident.

Category: Contact Information Clarity

Description: Make it obvious how to reach you and clarify the phone cannot accept texts.

Reason: Removes friction for people trying to make contact and encourages action.

Implementation Order

1. Home page banner and visuals
2. Quick contact information display
3. Easy appointment request form on contact page
4. Services and offers section
5. Certifications, badges, and emergency contact info

Risk Mitigation

Complex booking process

Category: Conversion

Suggested Action: Keep appointment request forms simple, test them with real users, and fix any confusing steps before launch.

Missing or unclear contact options

Category: User Experience

Suggested Action: Double-check all contact information is clear and up front, and explain the landline limitation.

Plugin integration failure

Category: Technical

Suggested Action: Test all plugin features, especially the Rotating Banner and Appointment Request, before going live.
