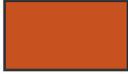

Imagery Style

Principle: Ease of Action

Application: Make it easy for visitors to get in touch as soon as they decide.

Implementation: Show a contact form or phone number in the page header and also at the end of each service description.

Content Strategy

Recommendation: Write clear, short summaries of each main service using phrases local homeowners use.

Implementation: Keep paragraphs short, use bullet points for benefits, and mention towns in Marin and Sonoma you serve.

Risk Mitigation

Plugin Security and Updates

Category: Technical

Suggested Action: Always keep gallery and review plugins updated, delete any unused plugins, and use only well-supported ones.

Slow Page Load from Large Images

Category: Performance

Suggested Action: Compress all images for web before uploading; use only necessary, high-quality images to keep the site loading fast.

Outdated Offers or Contact Info

Category: Operational

Suggested Action: Set a schedule to check and update special offers, phone numbers, and service areas at least every 6 months.
