### Sections

#### Intro

Purpose: Summarize your experience and what sets you apart.

Key Elements:

- Brief company background
- 20+ years of experience

- Funding loans others won't

Strategy: Establish trust and credibility before listing specifics.

Psychology: People trust experience; they are seeking an expert who solves problems others couldn't.

Tone: Reassuring, professional, and honest.

### **Service List**

Purpose: Clearly outline each loan program with a short description.

Key Elements:

- Construction Financing: short summary and who it helps
- Long Term Financing: short summary and who it helps

Strategy: Match client needs with your solutions; provide a direct button to inquire about each program.

Psychology: Visitors want to quickly find if you offer the right loan for them and an easy way to get started.

Tone: Simple, straightforward, and easy to skim.

Purpose: Explain why real estate investors should work with your firm and show how you support them.

### **Sections**

#### **Intro**

Purpose: Speak directly to investors and their concerns.

Key Elements:

- Statement about being the financial partner for real estate investors

Strategy: Position your business as an ally who understands the needs of investors.

Psychology: Investors need to feel their needs are understood and supported, especially if they have been turned away elsewhere.

Tone: Empathetic, knowledgeable, and supportive.

#### **Benefits**

Purpose: List clear reasons to choose you over other lenders.

Key Elements:

Strategy: Affirm their decision and push them to reach out for tailored advice.

- Short privacy statement

Strategy: Lower the barrier for first contact—make it as easy as possible.

Psychology: Quick forms encourage visitors to reach out without hesitation.

Tone: Welcoming and straightforward.

# Implementation

## UX Psychology

**Rationale:** Seeing successful funded deals makes visitors feel more confident starting a conversation.

**Implementation:** Use the Gallery to show recent deals, adding short captions and outcomes for each.

## Priority Focus

**Category:** Clarity and Trust

**Description:** Show what makes you unique and reliable right away.

**Reason:** Quick trust is needed in the finance industry, especially for customers turned away by traditional lenders.

**Category:** Gallery Page

**Description:** Show off your successful deals with images and details.

## Implementation Order

1. Update homepage and contact info for clarity
2. Create and rewrite service pages for each lending program

4. Add testimonials and special offers
5. Review and update SEO keywords on all pages
6. Make sure the design and images look modern and load well on phones/tablets

## Risk Mitigation

**Lack of Social Media**

**Category:** Visibility Risk

**Suggested Action:** Consider adding at least one business social media link in the future to improve online credibility, even if just a LinkedIn business page.

### **Outdated content or images**

**Category:** Perception Risk

**Suggested Action:** Replace all old images and revise text to be current and professional. Use plain language.

### **Missing Contact Options**

**Category:** Lead Loss Risk

**Suggested Action:** Check every page to make sure at least one way to reach you is always visible and working.
