# Implementation

## UX Psychology

## Content Strategy

**Area:** Homepage and Service Pages

**Implementation:** Use simple language to outline steps—from breeder check to puppy delivery—and add real-life stories or photos to reassure nervous buyers.

**Area:** Gallery Page

## Conversion Optimization

**Description:** Ensure every page works well on phones and tablets.

**Reason:** Most families search for puppies on mobile devices, so their experience must be smooth.

**Category:** Easy Payments and Delivery Info

**Description:** Make it simple to pay and understand how delivery works.

**Reason:** Clear info reduces confusion and makes it easier for nervous buyers to make a decision.

## Risk Mitigation

### Possible fake inquiries or spam from online forms

**Category:** Online Forms

**Suggested Action:** Use simple human-check methods (like a basic puzzle or math question) in the contact form to block spam.

### Slow pages due to image-heavy banners and galleries

**Category:** Website Speed

**Suggested Action:** Resize and compress photos before uploading to keep load times fast, especially for mobile users.

### **Payment errors or customer uncertainty with online store**

**Category:** Ecommerce

**Suggested Action:** Test every payment method before launch and display contact help clearly on the payment page.

### **Business Impact**

**Impact Level:** High
