Homepage (*Landing*)

Sections

Hero

Purpose: To make a strong first impression, share the Elite Dental brand, and invite visitors to engage immediately.

Key Elements:

- Business name and slogan: 'Elevating Smiles with Elite Care.'
- Large welcoming photo or practice image
- Logo displayed up front
- Clear contact information: phone, email, address
- Headline stating the personalized, gentle approach
- Button to contact you or book a free consultation
- Quick note: 'Hablamos Español'
- Special offer banner: 'Free Consultations & New pt cleanings with x-rays \$195 (reg. \$440)'

Strategy: Encourage visitors to call for a free consultation by making the phone number and offer stand out and adding a button for easy contact.

Psychology: People are often anxious about visiting the dentist; welcoming language and a clear offer of free or affordable services relieve anxiety, while listing the Spanish language option builds trust with a wider audience.

Tone: Use a friendly, reassuring tone that feels inviting and caring. Emphasize comfort, trust, and a modern approach.

Cta Block

Purpose: To quickly guide people toward taking action, like calling, booking a visit, or learning more about services.

Key Elements:

- Button to contact the office
- Button to book a consultation
- Short message on why to choose Elite Dental
- Repeat of special offer to reinforce value
- Simple instructions on how to book or call

Strategy: Make it easy to contact the office by putting buttons in visible spots and reminding visitors of the offer, encouraging them to reach out.

Contact Form
