- Professional logo
- Images that show history or credibility

Strategy: Gives visitors reasons to trust and buy from you instead of others.

Psychology: Personal stories and long history help build confidence and connection.

Tone: Friendly, experienced, and reassuring.

## **Contact (*Contact*)**

Purpose: Let visitors reach out with questions or business requests.

### **Sections**

#### **Contact Form**

Purpose: Make it easy to send you a message by email.

Key Elements:

- Simple form to fill out name, email, and message
- Clear statement: 'No phone or physical address displayed'
- Privacy reassurance

Strategy: Quick, no-barrier way for visitors to get in touch, leading to more business inquiries.

# Implementation

## UX Psychology
