UX Psychology

Principle: Show Value Instantly

Application: Put your slogan and main services at the very top so everyone quickly sees what you offer.

Implementation: Use your main banner image, slogan, and a short sentence explaining your reports and analysis right on the homepage.

Principle: Keep Choices Simple

Application: Avoid clutter, and make sure main actions like 'Buy Report' or 'Contact' are easy to find.

Implementation: Stick to a top menu with just a handful of clear options: Home, Reports, Subscription, Contact.

Content Strategy

Area: Product Detail

Recommendation: Each report should have its own page with a simple summary and what makes it valuable.

Implementation: Use content exactly as provided by you, keeping it clear and as-is for all service and product pages.

Area: Global Approach

Recommendation: Write everything so it makes sense for people around the world, even if English is not their first language.

Implementation: Use everyday words, avoid U.S.-only references, and always state 'electronic delivery'.

Conversion Optimization

Technique: Clear Buy Buttons

Rationale: People are more likely to buy if it's obvious where to click.

Implementation: Put large, noticeable 'Buy Now' or 'Get Report' buttons near the top of every product page.

Technique: Fewer Steps to Purchase

Rationale: Reducing clicks increases sales.

Implementation: Make sure people can go from seeing a product to buying it in the fewest steps possible.

Reason: This helps people trust your business and start buying with confidence.

Risk Mitigation

Missing or Slow Banner Images

Category: Site Performance

Suggested Action: Use only approved banner images and make sure files are not too large so the site loads fast.

People Can't Reach You

Category: Contact

Suggested Action: Double check the contact form works and goes to your email.

Broken Buy Buttons

Category: Ecommerce

Suggested Action: Test all 'Buy' or 'Get Report' buttons on every device, including phones and tablets.

Business Impact
