Imagery Style

Theme Style

Zen and inviting, with modern touches and natural details. Use lots of open space, subtle lines, and soft imagery. Avoid a cold, ultra-modern style. Focus on warmth and community.

Layout Approach

Keep the layout very easy to use, with clear sections and lots of space around text and images. Big buttons for booking, phone, and contact options should always be visible at the top. Requirements & Features

Homepage Design

Description: Show a large, high-quality image of the building and logo at the top. Make the address and phone number very easy to find. Put a 'Book Here' button on the right side of the heading.

Validation: Address and phone number are visible without scrolling. 'Book Here' button is visible on top right.

Class Booking Integration

Description: Add buttons like 'Book Here' and 'Buy Now' that send people to the Mindbody booking links for memberships and class packs.

Validation: All booking and buy now buttons lead directly to correct Mindbody links.

Class Schedule Widget

Description: Embed the Mindbody schedule widget directly on the Classes & Class Schedule page so people can see real-time class times.

Validation: Schedule appears on page and matches real Mindbody account.

Custom Contact Form

Description: Place a simple 'Register Here to Get More Information' contact form with name, email, phone, and comment box fields on the Teacher Training page. Submissions go to kathy@santoshayogacenter.com.

Validation: Form works and sends details to the right email.

Rotating Banner

Description: Showcase rotating images on the Home page using uploaded professional photos to create a welcoming and upscale look.

Validation: Banner displays multiple images from uploads and transitions smoothly.

Photo Gallery

Description: Include an image gallery for the 'Our Instructors' page and use the uploaded gallery images to highlight instructors and facility.

Validation: Gallery is easy to browse and includes all approved images.

Mobile Friendliness

Description: Make sure the site looks great and is easy to use on phones and tablets. Buttons and text should be simple to tap and read.

Validation: All content adjusts and works on various devices without zooming.

Easy Navigation

Description: Design the top menu and page links so it is simple for anyone to find information about classes, teachers, prices, location, and contact.

Validation: Main services and contact options reachable from every page in one or two clicks.

Mailing List Signup

Description: Place a 'Join Our Mailing List' option on the Home page, using the Mindbody widget as provided for capturing new leads.

Validation: Signup is easy and works via widget code from Mindbody.

Social Media Linkage

Description: Display Instagram link clearly for people who want to connect socially.

Validation: Instagram icon works and opens the correct page.

Page Structure & Recommendations

Homepage (*Landing*)

Purpose: Welcome visitors and clearly show what Santosha Yoga Center offers. Make it easy for people to find contact details, see class options, and feel the warmth and quality of the studio.

Sections

Hero

Purpose: This is the first thing visitors see. It gives a welcoming feeling, shows a picture of the building, the logo, and has the address and phone number right up top.

Key Elements:

- Main image of the building
- Logo
- Address and phone number shown clearly
- Book Here button on the right
- Rotating banner with other photos

Strategy: Make it easy to take action by placing the 'Book Here' button right at the top. Show the address and phone number so people know exactly where you are and how to reach you.

Psychology: People like feeling welcome and want things to be easy. Showing real photos and clear info gives a sense of trust and belonging right away.

Tone: Keep things friendly and calming. Use a warm, professional voice that makes people feel comfortable and supported. Mention community, modern space, and experienced teachers.

Cta Block

Purpose: Encourage visitors to join or book a class, sign up for news, or connect with the business.

Key Elements:

- 'Book Here' button
- 'Join Our Mailing List' button
- Instagram icon with link
- Mindbody login/register link

Strategy: Use simple, direct buttons and highlight next steps like booking a class or signing up for updates. Place call-to-action buttons in easy-to-see spots.

Psychology: Visitors are more likely to take action if options are clear and right in front of them. Providing just a couple of choices avoids overwhelm.

Tone: Stay inviting, positive and straightforward so people know what to do next.

About (*Info*)

Purpose: Share your studio's story, philosophy, and what makes it unique in the area. Help visitors understand your commitment to wellness and community.

Sections

Introduction

Purpose: Introduce Santosha Yoga Center and its values.

Key Elements:

- Story of how you started
- Mission or philosophy
- What sets you apart (modern, community-centric, experienced teachers)

Strategy: Use personal language to create a connection with the reader.

Psychology: People want to feel part of something meaningful and personal.

Tone: Warm, honest, and sincere. Focus on community, wellness, and high quality.

Our Instructors (*Info*)

Purpose: Introduce the teaching team so visitors feel confident and welcome. Show instructor photos and brief bios.

Sections

Instructors Gallery

Purpose: Showcase the instructors' photos and backgrounds.

Key Elements:

- Professional photo gallery
- Short bios for each teacher
- Qualifications and specialties

Strategy: Build trust by putting faces to names and highlighting qualifications.

Psychology: People are more likely to join if they see friendly, expert teachers.

Tone: Friendly, approachable, emphasizing expertise and warmth.

Class Offerings (*Info*)

Purpose: List all types of yoga and fitness classes offered, making it easy for visitors to find what's right for them.

Sections

Class List

Purpose: Briefly describe each class so visitors know what to expect (e.g., Power Flow, Pilates Flow, Santosha Flow, Iron Yoga Sculpt, Restorative Yoga with Sound Bath).

Key Elements:

- Class names
- Brief, simple explanations
- Who each class is best for

Strategy: Clear class choices and explanations lower uncertainty and help visitors pick a class.

Psychology: Giving people simple options makes decision-making easier and faster.

Tone: Clear, inviting, and motivational.

Purpose: Display the current class timetable and make it easy to book spots.

Sections

Schedule Embed

Purpose: Show the live class schedule right on the website using Mindbody widget integration.

Strategy: Visitors can see options at a glance and quickly book what works for them.

Key Elements:

- 200 Hour Teacher Training – dates, pricing, leaders
- Drop-in and class packages (5, 10, 20 packs)
- Buy Now buttons linking to Mindbody platform

Strategy: Make every offer clear and include direct action buttons for buying or joining.

Psychology: Presenting value and benefits next to pricing helps people feel good about spending.

Tone: Upbeat, transparent, and appealing. Highlight value and perks.

Teacher Training (*Info*)

Purpose: Promote your 200 Hour Teacher Training certification program, explain what's included, and encourage visitors to register.

Sections

Training Details

Purpose: Explain the teacher training, key dates, leaders, benefits, and how to sign up.

Key Elements:

- Overview of program
- Dates, instructors, and pricing
- Who it's for and what's covered
- Register Here form (custom contact form)

Strategy: Add a simple form for people to request more info or apply right away.

Psychology: Testimonials and a welcoming description help visitors imagine themselves joining.

Tone: Friendly, motivational, and supportive. Encourage growth and learning.

Contact (*Contact*)

Purpose: Give all the ways to get in touch, including location, phone, email, and a simple contact form.

Sections

Contact Details

Purpose: Share address, map, phone, and email so visitors can reach out or visit easily.

Key Elements:

- Full address and Google map
- Phone and email
- Hours of operation
- Short contact form

Strategy: Remove hurdles, making it easy for visitors to call, email, or send a quick message.

Psychology: Visible contact info builds trust and shows the business is open to connecting.

Tone: Polite, approachable, and clear.

- Company Story
- Team Profile
- Mission & Values

Implementation

UX Psychology

Principle: Simplicity

Application: Make the website layout calm, clear, and clutter-free to create a peaceful feeling that fits a yoga studio.

Implementation: Use lots of space, simple fonts, and soft colors. Keep menu choices limited and group information in easy-to-spot sections.

Principle: Trust and Community

Application: Show real images of the studio and instructors and use welcoming language so people feel comfortable and safe.

Implementation: Highlight the main photo and instructor gallery. Use friendly introductions and mention community focus on every page.

Principle: Quick Gratification

Application: Let people book a class, membership, or learn more in as few clicks as possible.

Implementation: Place 'Book Here,' 'Buy Now,' and 'Register' buttons in visible places, always leading right to what the visitor wants.

Content Strategy

Area: Service Pages

Recommendation: Explain each program in plain language with the benefits front and center. Use clear headings for each class type.

Implementation: List each class type description and emphasize perks of memberships, with simple summaries and easy links to book.

Area: Instructor Gallery

Recommendation: Tell personal stories and share photos of your instructors to help website visitors connect and feel part of the community.

Implementation: On the 'Our Instructors' page, match pictures with a short, friendly bio for each instructor.

Area: Homepage

Recommendation: Use your slogan and show off community, quality, and unique features within the first view.

Implementation: Include the tagline, a large photo, and a short intro paragraph at the top, plus quick ways to book or ask questions.

Conversion Optimization

Technique: Direct Action Buttons

Rationale: Making booking easy increases the chances people will try a class or sign up.

Implementation: Add clear buttons to book, buy, or register on every major page. Link directly to the Mindbody booking, registration, or purchase link.

Technique: Visible Contact Options

Rationale: People should never have to hunt for your address, phone, or contact form.

Implementation: Keep contact info in the top of every page and in the footer, and put a simple contact form where people expect it.

Priority Focus

Category: Booking Integration

Description: Connect all service pages, class schedules, and special offers directly to Mindbody booking and purchase options.

Reason: Makes it easy for people to become customers immediately.

Category: First Impression

Description: Place high-quality building and studio images and your slogan right at the top to show your brand's quality and warmth.

Reason: Builds trust and makes people want to stay and learn more.

Category: Easy Navigation

Description: Keep all pages simple and menu options clear so anyone can find what they need quickly.

Reason: Prevents frustration for busy customers and helps retain site visitors.

Implementation Order

1. Homepage layout and banner
2. Navigation/menu structure
3. Class schedule widget integration
4. Service and membership pages with booking links
5. Custom contact form on Teacher Training page
6. Instructor gallery setup
7. Mailing list/signup integration
8. Test on mobile devices
9. Check and update all live booking and contact links

Risk Mitigation

Outdated Schedule Information

Category: Booking

Suggested Action: Always use the Mindbody live schedule widget so class times stay current.

Contact Form Not Working

Category: Customer Service

Suggested Action: Test the contact form after launch and make sure emails are delivered without fail.

Plugin Overload

Category: Site Speed

Suggested Action: Only use necessary plugins for galleries, banners, and forms, and make sure each is up to date.
