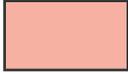

Validation: Pages open quickly (ideally in 2-3 seconds or less).

contact options

Description: Add a simple contact form so people can easily request appointments or ask questions.

Validation: Customers can send messages through a contact form and you receive them by email.

service listing

Description: Make it easy to find all spa services and prices so people can quickly decide what they want.

Validation: All main services are shown with simple descriptions and prices.

mobile experience

Description: Make sure the website looks and works great on phones and tablets so busy customers can book from anywhere.

Validation: Website displays clearly and buttons are easy to tap on all major phone and tablet sizes.

Page Structure & Recommendations

Homepage (*Landing*)

Purpose: Give a welcoming and clear first impression of the spa, instantly showing visitors what makes the business unique and inviting them to explore the services.

Sections

Hero

Purpose: Catch attention right away with a beautiful photo and a quick message that shares your spa's promise for relaxation and top-quality hair care.

Key Elements:

- Button visitors can click to book an appointment

Strategy: Make it easy for visitors to understand what's offered and how to take the next step, like booking or calling.

Cta Block

About (*Information*)

Purpose: Tell your story, share your values, and build trust by showing who you are, what you stand for, and why clients choose your spa.

Sections

Our Story

Purpose: Share why The Mane Tamer Hair Spa exists and what makes your approach special.

Key Elements:

- Short paragraph about Amanda and her passion for hair and wellness

- Photo of Amanda or the team
- Statement of values, such as commitment to client care and luxurious experience

Strategy: Connect emotionally by showing real people behind the business.

Psychology: Clients are more likely to book if they feel a personal connection.

Tone: Honest, down-to-earth, and personable.

Spa Experience

Purpose: Paint a picture of the relaxing, rejuvenating visit your clients can expect.

Key Elements:

- Photos of the spa environment
- Short description of the peaceful atmosphere
- List of complimentary touches (tea, calming music, aromatherapy, etc.)

Strategy: Help clients imagine themselves enjoying the experience.

Special Packages

Purpose: Highlight bundles or premium experiences for people who want something extra.

Key Elements:

- Pricing for bundles, if available

Strategy: Encourage higher-value bookings with bundle deals.

- Photos of treatments, hair results, and spa spaces
- Optional quotes from happy clients below photos
- Before-and-after images, clearly labeled

Strategy: Proof of quality brings new clients and reassures them.

Psychology: Seeing real results makes people more confident in booking.

Tone: Proud, confident—let photos and brief captions do most of the talking.

Implementation

UX Psychology

Principle: Keep things calm and simple

Application: Use relaxing colors, simple layouts, and clear menus so visitors feel comfortable and relaxed.

Implementation: Choose soft colors and keep each page uncluttered. Use clear menu names like 'Services', 'Book Now', and 'Contact'.

Principle: Build trust with real people

Application: Show real photos of your staff and spa areas to make the business feel more personal and inviting.

Implementation: Add a team section with friendly photos and short bios to the website.

Content Strategy

Area: Homepage

Recommendation: Quickly explain what makes your spa special at the top of the homepage.

Implementation: Add a short message about your unique hair spa experience right when people visit the site.

Area: Service pages

Recommendation: List services with plain-language descriptions and prices.

Implementation: Create a main services page with sections for each type of treatment and an easy-to-read price list.

Area: Reviews section

Recommendation: Highlight 3–5 positive real customer reviews near the booking area.

Implementation: Ask happy clients for a short testimonial and add these to the homepage or booking page.

Conversion Optimization

Technique: Make booking easy

Rationale: People are more likely to set an appointment if booking takes only a few clicks.

Implementation: Put a clear 'Book Now' button on every page, linking to an easy-to-use booking form.

Technique: Use clear contact info

Rationale: Customers trust a business more when they see a real phone number and address.

Implementation: Show your Atlanta address and phone number at the top and bottom of every page.

Priority Focus

Category: website platform transition

Description: Move to Bricks layout for reliability and faster updates.

Reason: Current platform causes delays; the business expects a smoother, more stable experience.

Category: contact options

Description: Make sure contact form and booking options are easy to use.

Reason: Clients want a quick way to connect, ask questions, and make appointments.

Implementation Order

1. Move the website from Elementor to Bricks and test all pages
2. Set up the contact form and check it sends messages
3. Add all services and prices clearly
4. Make sure the site works well on phones and tablets
5. Add customer reviews and team photos for trust
6. Speed up page loading with a caching plugin

Risk Mitigation

Possible plugin conflicts after switching builders

Category: technical

Suggested Action: Test all important features carefully after switching to Bricks, and remove old Elementor-only plugins.

Missed messages from contact form

Category: communication

Suggested Action: Test the contact form several times to make sure you get every request by email.
