Description: Online shop to offer services: Production, Recording, Mixing, Coaching, Mastering. Each product has the designated image except for stems mastering, which is skipped. Display pricing where available and follow the client's email/contact preferences.

Validation: Shop must show all required services with correct image and info. Store email set to defyrecordings@gmail.com.

Contact Info (global)

Description: Show the main contact email and phone number on every page: info@defyrecordings.com and 917-853-1485. Do not list the physical address.

Validation: Contact info is clearly visible on all pages, physical address not shown.

FAQs

Description: Include a Frequently Asked Questions section, using the existing website as reference.

Validation: FAQ content matches (or updates from) archived site.

High-Word Count for SEO

Description: Allow long-form content where needed, so search engines better understand Defy Recordings' services and expertise.

Validation: Pages are not limited by short content restrictions.

SEO Optimization

Description: Avoid using the search phrases 'Beats,' 'Hip Hop,' or 'R & B.' Focus search terms on music producer, recording engineer, and mastering engineer.

Validation: Forbidden words do not appear in SEO meta tags or copy.

PDF Download (Terms)

Risk Mitigation

Listing physical address

Category: Privacy

Suggested Action: Double-check that the physical address is not shown anywhere on the site.

Prohibited search phrases

Category: SEO

Suggested Action: Review all your copy and page settings to confirm that forbidden phrases like 'Beats' and 'Hip Hop' do not appear.

Plugin overload

Category: Site Stability

Suggested Action: Keep plugins to essentials only (like WooCommerce for the store) to reduce problems and make maintenance easier.
