# Implementation

## UX Psychology

**Principle:** Ease of Use

**Application:** Visitors want to find what they need quickly. Make navigation simple and repeat key contact information.

**Implementation:** Show a simple menu with no more than 5 options and keep phone and email in the header and footer.

**Principle:** Visual Proof

**Application:** Seeing real photos of your equipment and projects builds confidence.

**Implementation:** Feature actual pictures of your trucks, scales and team on home and service pages, not just a separate gallery.

## Content Strategy

**Area:** Services Clarity

**Recommendation:** Use everyday language to explain each service and highlight what makes you better than competitors.

**Implementation:** Write one short, clear paragraph per service page, using bulleted lists for unique features like 24-hour repair and NIST certification.

**Area:** Local Focus

**Recommendation:** Mention California regions and industries you serve.

**Implementation:** Include references to Central Valley, Bay Area and wine/almond/agricultural businesses in page titles and descriptions.

**Area:** Active Offers

**Recommendation:** Display your truck scale rental offer where people will notice.

**Implementation:** Add a colored box or badge on the homepage and truck rental page showing the included indicator package offer.

## Conversion Optimization

**Technique:** Place Contact Forms and Numbers Prominently

**Rationale:** People are more likely to call or write if it's easy to find how.

**Category:** conversion
