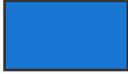

Imagery Style

Photos should show real people working in the plant, employees in branded shirts, and equipment in clean, well-lit settings. Use action shots to demonstrate expertise and teamwork. Stock photos of tools, molds, and plastic parts can fill gaps as needed, but real employee images should come first.

Overall Aesthetic

The site should feel modern, trustworthy, and easy to use. Clear sections, large images, and bold titles help visitors quickly find what they need. The look should impress manufacturers and new entrepreneurs, while still being welcoming and not overly technical.

Theme Style

Professional and industrial, with a touch of warmth from team and facility photos. Use a simple blue and white color scheme, with touches of bright blue for emphasis. Rounded buttons and image selection areas (like the round bubbles the customer likes) can help the site look friendly and interactive.

Layout Approach

Use clear boxes or cards for each section or service, like on the Wise Plastics site that the customer likes. Add movement to these boxes when hovered over and use blue highlights for selected areas. Place a large banner at the top, just like on the Quality Plastics site, to draw attention. Make sure the gallery and contact options are easy to find. The menus and buttons should be simple and obvious.

Regional Recommended

- Photos showing American manufacturing and local teamwork
- Clean, open layouts common in modern Texas and US B2B sites

Regional Avoid

- Small or light gray fonts
- Overly busy backgrounds
- Leftover red or gray color accents
- Crowded layouts or hidden menus
