**Validation:** Logo matches customer request. All marketing collateral is visible where client requested.

## No Rotating Banner

**Description:** Do not use a rotating banner on the homepage, as specifically requested by the client.

**Validation:** No banner rotation present on any page.

## Page Updates and Content Control

**Description:** Ensure the client can easily update gallery images as better photos become available. Set up a straightforward method for swapping out images.

# Page Structure & Recommendations

# Implementation

## UX Psychology

**Principle:** Control and Comfort

**Implementation:** Use clear menu labels like 'F5 Mandolins', 'Octave Mandolins', and 'Guitars'. Each page should have its own image gallery.

## Content Strategy

**Technique:** Mobile-Friendly Galleries

**Rationale:** Most musicians and buyers browse on their phones, so galleries and photos must look good and load quickly.

**Implementation:** Test all galleries on mobile devices to ensure images are easy to swipe through and load without long waits.

## Priority Focus

**Category:** Homepage Messaging

**Description:** Start with a homepage that tells visitors exactly what you do and why your instruments are unique.

**Reason:** This will create a strong first impression and help the site attract the right customers.

**Category:** Gallery Setup

**Description:** Set up each instrument page with an organized group of photos.

**Reason:** Buyers want to see the details and quality of each instrument, and this helps them decide to contact or purchase.

**Category:** Contact Simplicity

**Description:** Make it very easy for visitors to reach out through multiple channels.

**Reason:** Many serious buyers or musicians prefer phone or in-person connections and will leave if it's hard to get in touch.

**Suggested Action:** Double-check all links, forms, and contact info so every inquiry gets through immediately.
