- Explanation: The website uses clear industry language, service lists, and case studies on every page. The main navigation and page titles reinforce the focus on machine condition monitoring and reliability services. The only minor gap is the absence of a hero section and some generic section headings, but these do not prevent immediate understanding.

Actions Needed

- Optionally, add a hero section or tagline on the homepage for even faster recognition.
- Replace any 'Untitled Section' headings with descriptive text.

Tips for Strengthening

- Use a short, bold tagline above the fold on the homepage.
- Add industry icons or visuals near the top of key pages.
