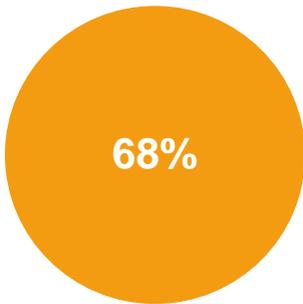

Accessibility & Functional

All Images have Alt Tags

Score: 100% | Status: Pass

All Images are Optimized for Web

No Broken Links appear on the Website

Evidence Summary: Most links are valid and internal. One external link on /about-us/ points to a non-existent or placeholder URL.

Issues Found:

The Website is Mobile Friendly

Score: 40% | Status: Fail

Checks For: Mobile responsiveness indicators including viewport meta tag presence and responsive framework/class markers in page markup
